LGBTQ+ People in the Punishment System Fact Sheet

LGBTQ+ youth are overrepresented in the juventile detention system

Among the youth general population 4-6% identify as LGBTQ+. 20% of youth in the juvenile detention system identify as LGBTQ+.

Probation and parole

People on parole and supervision are twice as likely to be LGBTQ+ than people not on probation and parole. Lesbian, gay, and bisexual adults in the criminal punishment system

Lesbian, gay, and bisexual individuals are 2.5 times more likely to be arrested than straight individuals. Lesbian and bisexual women are 4 times more likely to be arrested.

LGBTQ+ immigrants in detention Centers

LGBTQ+ immigrants held at federal detention centers are 97 times more likely to be sexually assaulted than other detainees.

Sentencing and incarceration

LGB people are 3 times more likely to be incarcerated than the total adult population. 85% of LGBTQ+ incarcerated individuals have been held in solitary confinement.

Trans people in the punishment system

Data on trans individuals in the punishment system is extremely scant. 1 in 5 trans people who have interacted with the police report harassment, including a staggering 38% of Black trans individuals.
